Greetings fellow Virginia Trojans,

The USC Alumni Association in conjunction with the USC Alumni Club of Central Virginia-Richmond and the USC Alumni Club of the Nation's Capital would like to offer you the opportunity of a lifetime. One of our members is leading an effort to develop a specialty license plate for USC alumni in the Old Dominion. We think this is a terrific way to showcase your Trojan Spirit and promote your alma mater everywhere you go!

The next steps in accomplishing this process are to receive 350 commitments from our alumni to pay an additional \$25 a year for the special USC-Virginia license plate and an additional \$10 for a personalized plate. The Alumni House will need to receive all monies and DMV forms by September 10, 2008. If we receive 350 registrations by September 10, the Alumni Association will process all payments and submit all the application forms and monies to the DMV. Alumni should then receive their license plates in approximately six to nine months. If we do not receive the minimum 350 applications, then all monies and applications will be returned after the September 10 deadline.

Enclosed is a sample of the license plate as well as the DMV application, which must be completed and mailed with payment to the Alumni Association. Check the box for "COLLEGE" and write in the University of Southern California in the space provided. If you are requesting a personalized plate, please note that there is a six character limit.


